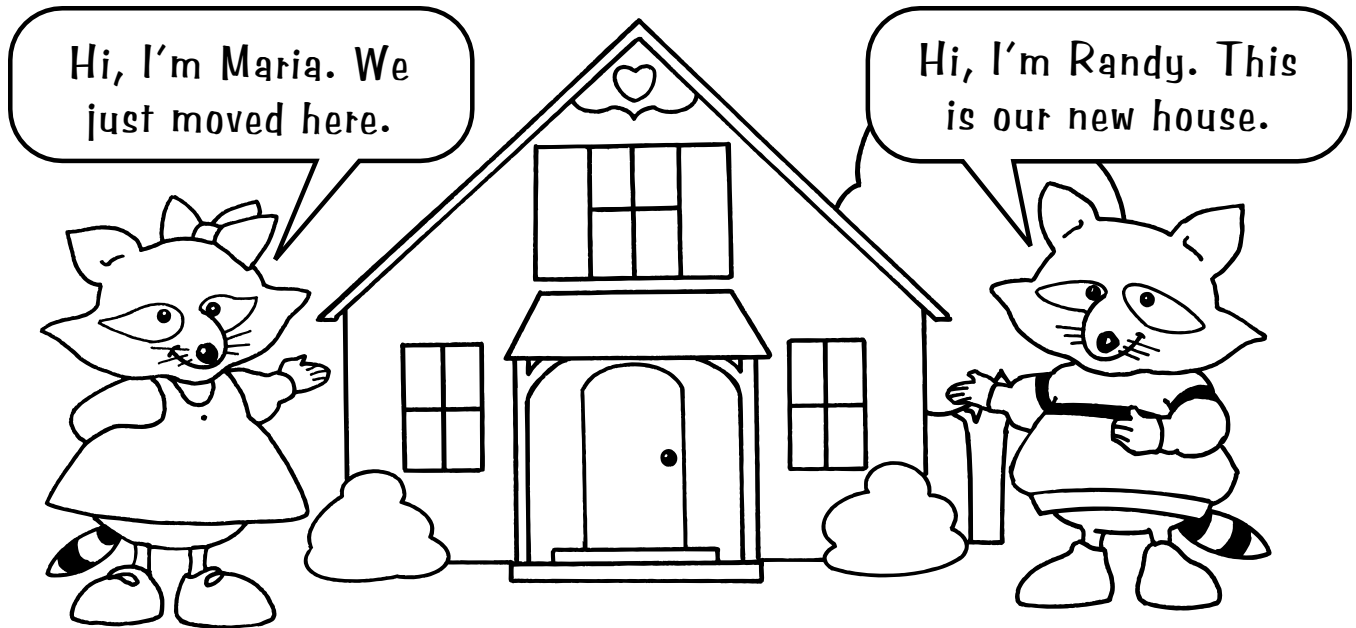

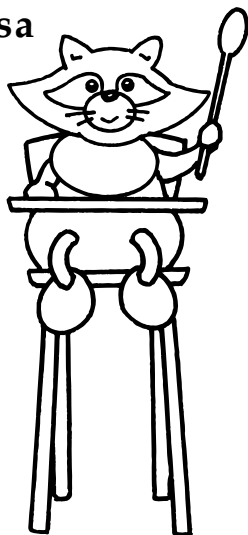

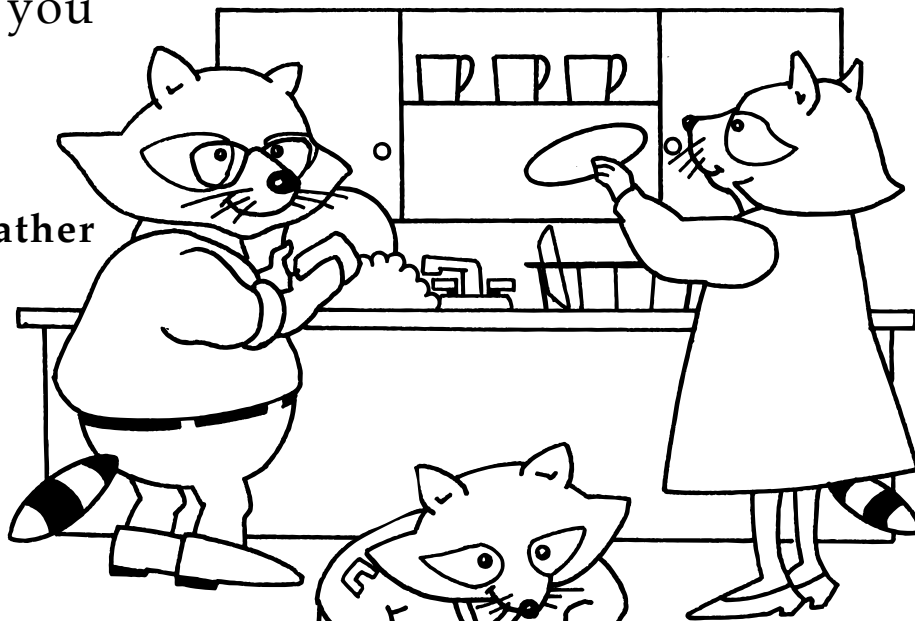
## Being Helpful

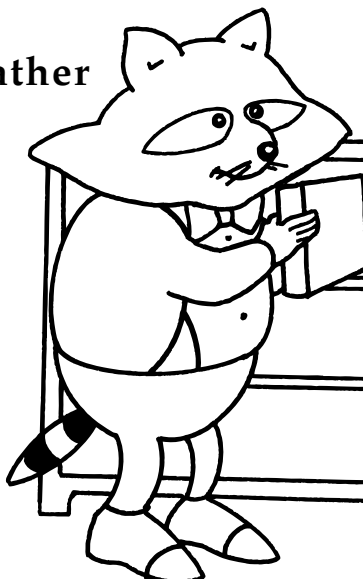
